HOW ARE STUDENTS GETTING TO CAMP?

STUDENTS & LEADERS WILL BE TRAVELING ON CHARTER BUSES TO GLORIETA.

WHAT HAPPENS IF THERE IS A MEDICAL ISSUE?

WE HAVE A LICENSED NURSE ON OUR LEADERSHIP STAFF WHO WILL BE IN CHARGE OF HANDLING MEDICATIONS, TENDING TO SICK STUDENTS, ANY INJURIES, ETC. IN THE EVENT OF A MEDICAL INJURY, THE STUDENT PASTOR WILL NOTIFY THE PARENTS. IN THE EVENT THAT A STUDENT NEEDS TO LEAVE CAMP, FOR EITHER MEDICAL OR BEHAVIORAL ISSUES, THE PARENTS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP THEIR STUDENT.

HOW CAN I COMMUNICATE WITH MY CAMPER?

IF YOU NEED TO REACH YOUR STUDENT DURING THEIR TIME AT CAMP, YOU WILL NEED TO CONTACT ONE OF THE EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS LISTED BELOW. STUDENTS WILL HAVE ACCESS TO THEIR CELL PHONES DURING THE BUS RIDE TO GLORIETA AND BACK, BUT THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO TURN IN THEIR PHONES TO LEADERSHIP STAFF ONCE WE ARRIVE AT CAMP. ONCE AT CAMP STUDENTS WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED ACCESS TO THEIR PHONE AT THE DISCRETION OF LEADERSHIP STAFF.

SHOULD I SEND CASH WITH MY CAMPER?

STUDENTS WILL NEED CASH FOR 4 MEALS DURING TRAVEL (EST. \$10 PER MEAL). THEY CAN ALSO BRING \$ FOR THE CAMP STORE (NOT REQUIRED, BUT RECOMMENDED) WHERE THEY CAN PURCHASE DRINKS, SNACKS & MORE.

DO STUDENTS NEED TO BRING ANY FORMS?

EVERY STUDENT WILL NEED 2 WAIVERS: (1) STUDENT LIFE WAIVER, (2) GLORIETA WAIVER. BOTH OF THESE MUST BE COMPLETED ONLINE BEFORE DEPARTURE. STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN VARIOUS REC GAMES LED BY STUDENT LIFE STAFF IN ADDITION TO WATER SLIDES, BLOB, DRIFT TRIKES, RAPPELLING, HIKING, ZIP-DROP, AND MORE.

WHAT TO BRING

- ONLINE FORMS COMPLETED
 - SNACKS & GAMES FOR THE BUS RIDES
 - SLEEPING BAG (OR TWIN SHEETS) & PILLOW
 - MEDICATION (IF NEEDED) IN ZIP-LOCK BAGGIE WITH STUDENT'S NAME ON IT
 - TRAVEL SIZE TOILETRIES
 - (TOOTHBRUSH, TOOTHPASTE, DEODORANT, SHAMPOO, SOAP, WASHCLOTH)
 - CASUAL AND MODEST CLOTHING FOR 4 DAYS
 - (CLOTHING FOR BUS RIDES, GROUP MEETINGS 4 DAYS OF ATHLETICS, 1 PAIR OF CLOTHES THAT CAN GET MESSY)
 - LIGHTWEIGHT TOTE BAG / BACKPACK (TO CARRY ITEMS AT CAMP)
 - DIRTY CLOTHES BAG
 - SUNSCREEN INSECT REPELLENT
 - BATH & SWIM TOWELS
 - SWIMSUIT (ONE PIECE FOR LADIES OR TWO PIECE WITH SHIRT)
 - CLOSE-TOED ATHLETIC SHOES (HIKING INCLUDED)
 - LIGHTWEIGHT JACKET OR PONCHO
 - WARM CLOTHING FOR NIGHT ACTIVITIES (TEMPERATURE CAN DROP INTO 50'S)
 - HAT / SUNGLASSES
 - WATER BOTTLE!!
 - WRISTWATCH
 - FLASHLIGHT
 - TRAVEL UMBRELLA
 - BIBLE, PEN, AND JOURNAL
 - \$ FOR 4 MEALS DURING TRAVELING
 - \$ FOR CAMP STORE
 - EAR PLUGS FOR BUS RIDE (IF NEEDED FOR SLEEP)
- **OUR GROUP WILL BE PART OF SURGE (BLUE) TEAM.
STUDENTS CAN BRING BLUE CLOTHING / GEAR.

DO NOT PACK MEDICATIONS IN YOUR CAMPER'S LUGGAGE. MEDICATIONS MUST BE CHECKED IN WITH OUR CAMP NURSE PRIOR TO DEPARTURE ON JULY 9.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

WE HAVE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY FOR DRUGS, ALCOHOL, OR SEXUAL MISCONDUCT. IF A STUDENT BREAKS THIS POLICY, PARENTS WILL BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY TO PICK UP THEIR STUDENT FROM CAMP AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE. STUDENTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO HAVE THEIR CELL PHONES ON THE BUS TO AND FROM CAMP. WE WILL BE COLLECTING CELL PHONES UPON ARRIVAL TO CAMP. STUDENTS INTENTIONALLY WITHHOLDING THEIR PHONES IS AN INTEGRITY ISSUE, AS WELL AS A DISTRACTION FROM THE PURPOSES OF CAMP. IN THE EVENT THAT A STUDENT BREAKS THIS POLICY, OUR LEADERSHIP WILL COLLECT THE PHONE AND NOTIFY PARENTS. THE STUDENT WILL NOT HAVE THEIR PHONE RETURNED TO THEM UNTIL WE ARRIVE TO CHURCH PROJECT.
